Kuentz-Bas, 2023 Alsace Blanc France	\$12	\$30
Much of the fruit from this wonderful and unique cornucopian blend of grapes of the Alsacean Region, it offers an evoking medley of orchard fruits and zesty candied citrus peel. The Kuentz-Bas is certain to deliver a delightful and provocative smile to all from the moment it graces the palate!		
Elvio Tintero, 2020 Langhe Arneis Piedmont, Italy	\$12	\$30
Arneis, which means “little rascal” in Piemontese dialect, is a grape varietal that when tasted blind offers the minerality of a dry Riesling with the rich texture and acidity of Sauvignon Blanc. Considering how quickly it goes from vine to press to bottle, it’s a remarkable, entirely satisfying creation. Fermented dry, it retains the gorgeous grape must aroma that typically fades with fermentation, giving us a wine reminiscent of ripe pear and gardenias—a quintessential choice for bright salad courses.		
E. Welch Pinot Grigio Alto Adige, Italy	\$12	\$40
It captivates with a light straw-yellow color and offers fruity aromas of ripe pear, hints of sage, and a whiff of white pepper. On the palate, it delivers a lovely minerality, creamy texture and bright, crisp acidity.		
Babylonstoren, Chenin Blanc, 2023, South Africa	\$13	\$40
A crisp and refreshing wine with lovely guava and melon flavours for the hot summer months. Best enjoyed with salads or just for sipping while watching the sunset. Soft pressing, cold fermentation in stainless steel tanks for 3 weeks. Racked of fermentation lees and kept on thin lees for 4 months before bottling.		
Glassmen Chardonnay Sonoma County, CA	\$14	\$48
The wine opens with a vibrant aroma of lemon, lime, and white peach, layered over hints of crushed seashells and toasted French oak. It strikes an elegant balance between a rich, silky texture and bright, refreshing acidity, keeping it focused and clean on the palate.		
Napa Valley Quilt, 2023 Chardonnay California	\$16	\$55
For this Chardonnay, we rely almost entirely on vineyards from the Carneros District where the climate is distinctly cooler and foggier than ‘up valley’. Carneros is a world unto itself. Much of its soil is dense clay due to the region’s proximity to San Pablo Bay. This soil, combined with the marine influence of cool winds, brings about Chardonnay fruit with impressive structure and a flinty minerality.

Far Niente, 2023 Chardonnday Napa Valley, California Far Niente Chardonnay is a blend of superlative Napa Valley vineyards located in Coombsville. The 2023 vintage enchants with a bouquet of citrus, white floral, and hints of honeydew melon and nectarine. Raen, 2022 Lady Marjori Chardonnay | Sonoma County, CA

Born from the remote, rugged landscape of the Sonoma Coast, this second vintage release of Lady Marjorie Chardonnay hails from the rocky soils of Fort-Ross Seaview, resulting in a wine of incredible depth and vibrancy. White peach, crunchy nectarine, crushed wet gravel and white spring flowers jump from the glass. On the palate, these aromas are spliced with zesty lime blossom, stone fruits and fresh apricot, which integrates seamlessly with a backbone of mineral-laced acidity and subtle notes of salinity that all lead to a long, bright finish. With Raen founders also having Contium wines on their resumé, they fully leverage their pedigree in their creation of Lady Marjori and a fabulous lineup of wines.

The Heintz family has owned the ranch for over 100 years. Ideal Goldridge soil, healthy, mature vines, warm days balanced with cool nights and a grower who has been working the land since 1982 all contribute to Robert Parker's assessment of the vineyard as "...one of the great grand cru Chardonnay sites in California."

Arkenstone Estate 2021 Sauvignon Blanc | Napa, Valley, CA

A Bordeaux-style blend of 94% Sauvignon Blanc and 6% Sémillon offering remarkable structure, bright acidity, and rich, layered complexity. This medium to full-bodied white wine features exotic flavors of pineapple, citrus, Gravenstein apple, and salted almonds alongside the bright acidity.

Envinate, 2022 Benje | Canary Islands, Spain

Benje Tinto is sourced from 1,000 meters elevation, old-vine, pie franco parcels of Listan Prieto (Mission) with a bit of Tintilla, named "Masca," "La Zanja," "Valle de Arriba," and "Llano Redondo", all of them located in Santiago del Teide. Each parcel is hand-harvested and vinified separately, some in concrete and some in small open tubs. Maceration is 10-30 days (depending on parcel) with daily punch-down; malolactic fermentation is in neutral French barriques, then raised 8 months in the same barrels without battonage. Bottling is without fining or filtration.

An iconic, rich, and fruit-forward red wine known for its dark color, velvety tannins, and smooth, approachable style. It features prominent notes of cassis, blackberry, cocoa, and sweet vanilla.

Badia al Colle 2024 Chianti | Tuscany, Italy

This is a vibrant, ruby-red Tuscan red wine blend primarily composed of Sangiovese and a touch of Ciliegiolo. It delivers refreshing acidity, soft tannins, and rich, fruit-forward aromas of mature red and black cherries with subtle hints of herbs and almonds.

An elegant, food-friendly California red wine that offers aromas of wild blackberries, black cherry, and blueberry, with hints of pepper, mocha, and toasted clove.

Domaine Michel Juillot 2023 Mercurey Rouge | Burgundy, France

An elegant, food-friendly California red wine that offers aromas of wild blackberries, black cherry, and blueberry, with hints of pepper, mocha, and toasted clove.

Herman Story, 2021 Nuts and Bolts | Paso Robles, California

Winemaker Russel From brings an exciting expression of cabernet sauvignon. The glass reflects a dense and concentrated deep-ruby color. The aromas are led by a lush landscape full of plum, mulberry, cassis, and a hint of sweet tobacco. The mouthfeel is muscular and broad, with plenty of dark fruit and baking spice held up by stern tannins, then resolving in a long-lasting finish. As critic Jeb Dunnuck wrote, "It brings way more texture, purity, and balance than you'd expect at the price."

Desparada, 2022 Tempranillo | Paso Robles, California

Blackberry bolognese, mahogany doors into the future, tying cherry stems with your tongue, take a nap on a granite step, goth rapunzel, full body shivers, ruby roundabout. Harvested September 2022, aged in 60% once-filled French oak by Ermitage and 40% neutral barrels.

Cattleya Cuvée Number One 2021 Pinot Noir | Russian River Vally, CA

The 2021 Cuvée Number One is a full-bodied Pinot Noir known for a plush texture. It features flavor notes of dark cherry, blueberry, and spice.

Due del Monte 2019 Merlot | Friuli, Italy

A full-bodied Italian red wine from the Friuli-Venezia Giulia region that offers a velvety complex profile of wild berries, plum, subtle herbal or graphite notes, and spice with refined, silky "cotton" tannins.

Summer Dreams 'Stargazing' 2023 Pinot Noir | Sonoma Coast, CA

An exquisite, cool-climate California red crafted by winemaker Jayson Woodbridge (of Hundred Acre). Hailing from the extreme Sonoma Coast, this medium-bodied wine is celebrated for its silkiness, vibrant acidity, and notes of wild strawberry, blue fruit, and delicate spice.

Herman Story, 2021 Slide Hill Paso Robles, California		\$120
All the triumph and unbridled pleasure of freewheeling down the Columbia Gorge Highway in a 1963 Jeep Gladiator while you should be at a board meeting. Black gooseberry granite cliffs, peppered rabbit jerky, wild raspberry from roadside stands, broiled Simka plum buckshot, bramble-tangled blowtorch, and loganberry brandy from a black steel flask. Those boardroom big-shots and spreadsheet slideshows will have to wait, because this is the best wrong turn you've ever made.		
Herman Story, 2022 Milk & Honey Blend Paso Robles, California		\$125
A bold, highly concentrated red blend from Paso Robles, California that is celebrated for its opulent profile, combining dark fruit flavors with a plush, silky texture. It brings aromas of crushed blackberries, plum preserves, violet, and dark spices. The palate is rich and full-bodied with notes of dark chocolate, cured meats, and toasted sandalwood, backed by a strong backbone of velvety tannins.		
Fait-Main, 2022 Cabernet Paso Robles, California		\$175
The Fait-Main Paso Robles Cabernet Sauvignon reveals pure, nuanced flavors of blue fruit and blackcurrant, accompanied by floral and spice notes. This wine features seamless oak integration and smooth tannins, culminating in an elegant lasting finish.		
Senses Bodega Thieriot 2021 Pinot Noir Sonoma Coast, CA		\$180
Planted in 2016 by actor/vintner Max Thieriot and his childhood friends, the estate is located five miles from the Pacific Ocean, making it the coolest site in the Senses lineup. Known for its elegance and energy, this cool-climate Pinot Noir offers layered flavors of black cherry, dark raspberry, dried florals, tea, and subtle savory undertones.		
Herman Story, 2019 Chelle Mountain Cabernet Paso Robles, California		\$190
All the unexpected wonder of finding a pristine Steinway Fibonacci in the most rough-and-tumble bar in town. There she is, all dark mahogany and currant luster. Silky ivory and black licorice keys, 24K strings with clove and Sichuan peppercorn resonance. Aged in 100% new French oak for 30 months.		
Maxem Silver Eagle, 2021 Pinot Noir Sonoma Coast, California		\$190
A Sam Kaplan masterpiece! The 2021 Silver Eagle Vineyard is planted to the "VR" clone, originally brought over from the epic winegrowing region known as Vosne-Romanée, home to Domaine de la Romanée-Conti, one of Burgundy's most storied vineyards and wines. This gorgeous wine displays a ruby-purple hue with a deep core of black raspberries, red raspberry compote, fresh blackberries, a waft of cinnamon stick, and an extraordinarily savory nose of Sichuan pepper and Indian spices.

Riise Jovian, 2019 Tempranillo Blend | Paso Robles, California

\$195

After building the highly successful Realm Cellars in Napa Valley, vintner Juan Mercado set his sights on Paso Robles with the vision of cultivating a globally respected wine brand. Mercado founded RIISE in 2019 to produce world-class Rhone varietal and Tempranillo-based wines that are powerful, textural, and light on their feet. The fruit comes from three estate properties and several of the area's other most acclaimed vineyard sites, the majority of which are overseen by top vineyard managers Kevin Wilkinson and Lucas Pope. The wines are brought to life by winemaker Anthony Yount.

Hertelendy, 2018 Cabernet | Napa Valley, California

Small production. Big impact. Only 449 cases made of this 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon — a bold yet elegant powerhouse crafted from Napa's most prestigious volcanic sites, including Atlas Peak and our Rockwell Ridge estate at the top of Crystal Springs AVA. Composed of 87% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Malbec, 5% Petit Verdot and 3% Cabernet Franc, this wine was aged for 23 months in 90% new French and Hungarian oak, delivering exceptional depth, structure, and sophistication in every sip.

Castiel, 2021 Howell Mountain Cabernet | Napa Valley, California

The 2021 Castiel Cabernet comes entirely from the steep, higher elevation slopes of Howell Mountain AVA, which is perched on the eastern edge of Napa Valley. The 2021 Cabernet shows mulberry, fresh boysenberry, bay leaf and forest floor aromas, with a touch of baked cherry pie and notes of cocoa dust. At entry, the fruit flavors are profound and complex, with juicy black berry fruit dominant, then supported with baking spices, cocoa dust, a nuance of dried leaves and bark. Bright fruit acidity adds lift throughout the palate impression, and the finish is a mixture of nubby, slightly sinew-y tannins, juicy cherry and cola flavors, and fresh raspberries.

Andremily, 2020 Syrah No. 9 | California

If you are familiar with the cult-status wines of Sine Qua Non, close your eyes and you'll immediately recognize the aromas distinctive of Manfred Krankl. It's no surprise, as owner-winemaker Jim Binns was cellar master at Sine Qua Non for 12 vintages. The 2020 No. 9 is a blend of 89% Syrah, 9% Mourvèdre and 2% Viognier, made with 50% whole clusters. Fruit comes from several vineyards throughout the Central Coast including Slide Hill, White Hawk, Larner, Harrison-Clarke, Kimsey and Alta Mesa and was aged for 22 months in 65% new and 35% used French barriques. Opaque ruby-purple in color, it features aromas of black olives, ground coffee, turned earth and forest floor, before unfolding to pure blueberry liqueur, cassis, licorice and violet — what alluring aromas! Full-bodied, the palate is grainy and seamless, with concentrated, floral fruits and a very long, nuanced finish. Only 850 cases and a few magnums of this powerful Syrah were bottled. Consider us as exceptionally lucky to be afforded a very small allocation of this highly sought after wine!

Khanda, 2021 Coombsville Cabernet Napa Valley, California		\$210
The 2022 Khanda is a very pretty wine. The blend of 41% Cabernet Franc, 31% Cabernet Sauvignon and 28% Malbec works so well here. Crushed flowers, orange peel, mint, cinnamon and mocha are beautifully delineated. Silky tannins extend the mid-palate and finish effortlessly. This is super-polished and beautifully done		
Domaine de Courcel Pommard Grand Clos 2019 Burgundy, France		\$225
The 2019 Domaine de Courcel Pommard Grand Clos des Épenots 1er Cru is a highly structured, age-worthy Pinot Noir from Burgundy, France. It showcases deep cherry and red berry fruit and earthy minerality with a firm tannic backbone.		
Andremily, 2019 "EABA" Rhone Blend California		\$250
The 2019 EABA ("End All Be All") is a blend of 61% Syrah, 24% Mourvèdre, 13% Grenache and 2% Viognier and was made with 65% whole clusters. Fruit comes from several vineyards in Santa Barbara and San Luis Obispo counties, including Bien Nacido, White Hawk, Larner, Harrison-Clarke, G2 and Alta Mesa. It was matured for about 22 months in 55% new French barriques and 600-liter demi-muids and 45% used French barriques, and it was bottled on August 21, 2021. Opaque ruby-purple in color, it offers beautiful, pure scents of licorice, tar, blueberry and black cherry jam, charcuterie, pepper, olive and fried savory herbs, offering up more nuances as it spends time in the glass. Medium-bodied, it has abundant, super-fine tannins, seamless acidity and slowly expanding, spicy flavor layers, finishing very long and alluringly floral.		
Rewa, 2021 Coombsville Cabernet Napa Valley, California		\$260
The 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon is terrific. It offers tons of textural richness in a pretty overt style for Coombsville. Blackberry, chocolate, licorice, spice, leather and gravel are all amplified in this potent, heady Cabernet. Bright acids and lifted floral top notes resonate on the close. At the finish the wine is both juicy and structured with fine-grained tannins.		
Joseph Phelps, 2019 Insignia Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley, California		\$470
Another beautiful wine from this team, the 2019 Insignia is mostly Cabernet Sauvignon but includes smaller amounts of Merlot and Malbec, brought up all in new barrels, sourced from seven estate vineyards. On the nose, it features restrained cedar and vanilla notes and delicate herbal shadings accenting cassis and black cherry fruit. Full-bodied, velvety and somewhat open on the palate, it turns plush and long on the finish, adding a touch of warmth. The 2019 Insignia marks the first vintage to include fruit from the new Joseph Phelps vineyard named El Venadito, located in the Oak Knoll District, just south of the winery's Yountville Vineyard. Production this year is approximately 17,000 cases, reflecting the increased volume coming from recently replanted vineyards. It's remarkable what a good job they continue to do with this bottling year after year, without compromising on quality.
